## This funding will be used to


- Provide support for students in Years 3 and 5 to achieve at or above National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Literacy and Numeracy in 2017.
- Provide quality intervention and learning support programs in literacy and numeracy for all students who are at risk of not achieving NMS.
- Improve teacher capability through focussed coaching and professional development.

## Our initiatives include

- Employing an additional teacher aide to implement intervention programs to support students identified as not likely to reach NMS.
- Consolidating teacher capability to implement early intervention reading programs with small student groups.
- Professional development for teaching staff to unpack the Australian Curriculum (English and Mathematics).
- Teacher planning, moderation and coaching opportunities to improve capabilities.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

Action	Cost
• Employing an additional teacher aide to support individuals and small groups in a multi-age setting.	\$18,000
• Professional Development to develop teacher capability in delivering early intervention reading program	1,000
• Teacher release time to plan English and Mathematics units collaboratively, attend moderation sessions and participate in coaching sessions.	1,475
