5	Embedding the culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to

1	Providing targeted professional learning on the teaching of writing supported by planning, modelling, observation and feedback processes for teachers and teacher aides.	\$ 2,000
2	Purchasing additional teacher aide time to support individual students, especially students with disabilities, and small groups of students in a multi-age setting for targeted writing support.	\$ 10,000
3	Providing teacher release time to collaboratively plan English, attend pre/post moderation sessions and participate in coaching sessions.	\$ 1,800
4	Providing targeted professional development for teachers and teacher aides in understanding and developing skills to manage student behaviour, specifically related to Austistic Spectrum Disorder.	\$ 2,210
